The Closing the Achievement Gap Consortium and Concordia University Wisconsin have been considering a trip for returning African-American Female Initiative students to Washington, D.C. for the summer of 2020. COVID-19 has changed that planning and there will not be an AAFI summer of 2020 Washington, D.C. trip. Dr. Monica Kelsey-Brown of the Brown Deer School District has been leading the planning for a possible AAFI Washington, D.C. trip. Dr. Kelsey-Brown has been consulting with advisory groups, Superintendents and individuals in developing a culturally, historically and educationally valuable experience for the girls involved in the AAFI. The trip has been postponed with the intent to reschedule the event for 2021. Dr. Kelsey-Brown will continue to lead the planning for the rescheduled AAFI Washington, D.C. trip. The Closing the Achievement Gap Consortium and Concordia University Wisconsin will keep you up-to-date on the continuing planning process for a 2021 AAFI trip to Washington, D.C.
